1. To choose a moderator for said meeting.
2. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon the following resolution:

RESOLVED: That the Town of Brooklyn appropriate from the General Fund the sum of Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Eight and 00/100 (\$72,248.00) Dollars as recommended by the Board of Finance to cover the costs related to the removal and replacement of an oil tank at the Brooklyn School.

3. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon a proposed Anti-Blight Ordinance. A copy of said ordinance is on file in the Office of the First Selectman and available for public inspection during normal business hours.
4. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon a proposed Ordinance Amending an Ordinance creating the Brooklyn Land Acquisition Fund. A copy of said ordinance is on file in the Office of the First Selectman and available for public inspection during normal business hours.
5. To determine the wishes of those present and eligible to vote upon an Ordinance Concerning Appropriations. A copy of said ordinance is on file in the Office of the First Selectman and available for public inspection during normal business hours.
